Onsite services

- Diagnose and treat acute healthcare needs including, but not limited to sore throat, earache, vaginal and urinary problems, etc., while collaborating with the patient's primary care physician
- Manage chronic illness including, but not limited to diabetes, arthritis, high blood pressure, etc.
- Write prescriptions
- Make referrals to the patient's network provider for medical appointments
- Administer immunizations
- Conduct adult physicals (every other physical required with primary care physician)
- Conduct pediatric physicals (every other physical required with pediatrician)
- Work with the patient to develop an individualized wellness plan based on the patient's own risk factors
