The InSinkErator Employee Health Center, in partnership with Ascension Wisconsin, works with employees and their family members to achieve health and wellness goals by providing services ranging from primary and preventive care and chronic disease management.

The health center is available to all active employees of InSinkErator (whether the employee is covered under InSinkErator's medical insurance or not). Any spouse, domestic partner or dependent children aged 2 or older who are covered under the employee's medical insurance through InSinkErator can also use the health center.

What sets us apart

The InSinkErator Employee Health Center provides accessible health and wellness resources that improve the well-being of employees and their dependents. The staff provides high quality care to treat, reverse and prevent disease that match each individual's needs.

Services offered

The InSinkErator Employee Health Center can serve as your primary care provider or will work in collaboration with your established primary care physician. The clinic provides comprehensive services including:

Clinic visits

- Annual physical exams/wellness exams
- Sports physicals
- Sick visits
- Onsite medication prescribing
- Chronic condition management/education
- Nutrition Education
- Women's & Men's Health
- Immunizations and vaccinations
- Point of care testing and lab draws

Preventive exams and health screenings

- Behavioral health screenings
- Cervical cancer/PAP smear
- Prostate cancer
- Blood pressure checks
- Skin cancer



Convenient care when and where you need it

What does it cost to visit the health center?

The copay is \$20 per visit. The health center does not submit the office visit copay to the insurance company (lab charges are submitted to the insurance, if applicable). If employees wish to submit the copay to their insurance, they can pick up the forms in the health center.

Copay options are credit card, FSA debit card or HSA debit card. Payroll deduction is not offered.

If the nurse practitioner/doctor wants to see the patient back for a follow-up appointment (within two weeks of the initial consultation), one follow up is allowed without having to pay another copay.

Wellness-related (preventive care) visits are not subject to a copay per the Affordable Care Act. Blood pressure checks and blood draws are not subject to a copay. However, if lab work has to be sent out for analysis, those charges will be billed to the patient's medical insurance.
